DMR Scholarship Requirements
Shark Fest 2011**

I. About the Scholarship:

- The Mississippi Department of Marine Resources (DMR) will be sponsoring selected individuals to participate in the Gulf Coast Research Laboratory's marine education summer camp, Shark Fest 2011. The Marine Education Center is seeking qualified individuals who sincerely wish to learn about marine sciences and the environment. DMR will provide the cost of the camp. **The Marine Education Center does not provide travel to and from camp.**

II. Applicants must:

- Be willing to participate in activities such as fishing, boating, lab dissections.
- **Sincerely** be interested in a fun, outdoor, marine learning experience.

III. Candidate Selection:

- Candidates will be selected based on criteria listed on the scholarship form.
- There will be a limit on how many times a scholarship may be awarded to an eligible camper. One camper, per summer, for one week. First time campers will be given priority over all returning campers.

IV. Scholarship:

- Complete the scholarship application form.
- Print and fill out scholarship application.
