Southern Flounder (*Paralichthys lethostigma*)



Look for spotted topside varying in color from light to dark brown (three distinct eye-spots is characteristic of a Gulf Flounder)

If you catch a Southern Flounder, please:

1. Write down collection information  
Date, Time, and General Location
2. Put whole fish on ice in a Ziploc bag with collection information
3. Contact the Gulf Coast Research Laboratory to arrange pick-up
4. We will collect samples and give you the fillets
